### Requirements

### **Job Description**

The primary function of this position is to conduct project planning and manage engineering activities and construction projects at all Spokane Airport's properties. This includes project design management, tenant construction improvements, and project compliance. The supervisory duties are to direct and manage the Engineering Department and staff. This position reports to the Airport Director.

The major responsibilities include: establish Engineering Department goals and objectives and recommend necessary staffing and financial resources; plan, budget, schedule, and identify potential funding for capital improvement/construction projects; manage approved construction projects, reviewing design/plans, selecting contractors/consultants, administering contracts, coordinating schedules ,and approving change orders/invoices; manage the administrative functions of the Engineering Department; prepare technical reports/evaluations and make written/oral presentations; assure compliance with project management policies/ procedures and environmental standards; ensure DBE and ADA compliance; conduct project planning; manage and implement AIP grants; and perform other duties as assigned.
